On the basis of the Commission's findings, the judge appointed a commission of inquiry to determine whether the operators of the Sjumala nuclear power plant had been negligent in their supervision and control of operations. In doing so he stressed that it would "appear that the members of the Norwegian authorities who are responsible for supervising the project did not follow Norwegian law in giving full information and support to the applicant". He ruled that the Norwegian authorities had not "handled the matter in a satisfactory manner". The results of the inquiry were announced on 11 January 2007, in which the inspectors found that the Sjumala plant had been built without all the necessary permission, contrary to existing regulations, and that the supervision and control of operations had not been conducted in accordance with the regulations. After the NISA report, the Norwegian Energy Directorate was given a large part of the responsibility to supervise and control operations at Sjumala, with the inspections also including regular physical examinations of the plant and staff. The new rules will ensure that no operators of nuclear power plants in Norway can be licensed to operate until they have received approval from the regulator. The company's license will be suspended as of 31 January 2007, meaning the company will be forced to leave the market. The owners have repeatedly rejected allegations of illegal operations and compensation for the current owners, who still have the option to purchase the shares from the former owners. In May 2008, the Norwegian authorities announced that they have rejected the company's request for more information to prove it was not in contravention of its license conditions, and the owners had therefore agreed to withdraw their appeal against the license suspension. According to the state-owned electricity company Storeten, which is responsible for the management of Sjumala, the owners still have two years to purchase the shares, after which the state will take over and close the plant. The owners have since continued to refuse to purchase the shares. The company has also refused to enter a compensation agreement with the state-owned enterprise.
